TRISTATE CAPITAL HOLDINGS REPAYS TARP IN FULL

PITTSBURGH – October 2, 2012 – TriState Capital Holdings, Inc. (TriState Capital) announced today that it has repaid all \$23 million received in February 2009 through the Troubled Asset Relief Program (TARP).

TriState Capital launched in 2007, just two years before global financial markets became severely strained. TriState Capital used TARP investment funds to approve more than \$200 million in new commercial loans, spurring local and regional economic growth.

“We used TARP money for exactly the purpose it was intended, to continue making solid loans when credit was limited,” said Jim Getz, chairman and CEO of TriState Capital.

The repayment transaction was comprised of preferred securities, issued under the U.S. Treasury’s Capital Purchase Program. All such shares now have been repurchased by TriState Capital for full face value. Throughout the term, the bank paid an additional \$4.5 million in dividends to the U.S. Treasury.

TriState Capital Bank, a subsidiary of TriState Capital, remains the largest start-up bank in Pennsylvania history. TriState Capital Bank has grown to include offices in the Philadelphia area, Cleveland, Princeton and New York City.
